#### Curriculum Vitae

Grammatiki A. Karla holds a B.A. and an M.A. in Classics from the University of Athens, and a Ph.D. from the Freie Universität Berlin (1996-2000). During that time she also worked as a teaching assistant at the Universities of Bonn and Hamburg, while during 2002-2003 she was employed as a teaching assistant at the Freie Universität Berlin, funded by a grant by the Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft. She has held the post of Junior Researcher at the Research Centre for Modern Greek Dialects – Historical Dictionary of the Academy of Athens (2003-2007), and since April 2007 she is a member of the Department of Classics of the University of Athens (lecturer 2007-2011, assistant professor 2011-2019, associate professor 2020-). She has published books with international publishing houses, has edited collective volumes and has also written a large number of articles in international academic journals.

#### Research Interests

Ancient Greek literature with special focus on the ancient novel, fictional biography (*Life of Aesop*, *Life of Alexander the Great*), ancient rhetoric, especially during the Imperial times and Late Antiquity, textual criticism and textual edition.
